He participated with the singer (and father) Cucuza Hernán Castiello in the last four editions of the Tango Festival of Buenos Aires.

He played with great guitarists such as Hugo Rivas, Carlos Juarez, Horacio Avilano, Diego Kvitko, Leandro Nikitoff, Adrian Lacruz, Mariano Heler, Maximiliano Luna, among others, and accompanied several of the most recognized in the current scene male and female singers: Chino Laborde, Juan Villarreal, Cucuza Castiello, Barbara Grabinsky, among others.

Integra also the duet "CastielLos" (next to Cucuza Castiello) with whom they come in various milongas as "La Milonga del Morán" or "Salon Canning". Member also the guitar trio "PBT's" (tango and folklore) with who also has appeared in several places between any of them "The 36 Billiards"
